



IIM Rohtak Organizes TEDx Themed: Vulnerability in Veracity

‘Vulnerability in Veracity’ was the theme of the fourth edition of TEDxIIMRohtak organized on Sunday, November 4, 2018. In the event speakers from all spheres of life engaged with the audience by exploring the theme from their unique perspectives.

The event was inaugurated by the Chief Guest Prof. Dheeraj Sharma, who started by stating the fact, “We’re living in the most peaceful era of mankind and yet we are vulnerable to a number of things that arises from Technology, Entertainment, and Design”, He further added, “Lack of trust is one of the biggest challenges in our society right now, and the need to cultivate and maintain trust in individuals and institutions remains of paramount importance.”

In a highly engaging speech, RJ Rocky said, “It is only by identifying the truth about your strengths and weaknesses that you take a step towards success. Ensure that you are confident throughout and work towards converting your weaknesses to strengths”.

Mr. Shammi Narang, a Filmmaker, Actor, Audio visual consultant, and a media entrepreneur, talking about the important role of the youth in India said, “The news industry has adapted to the changing times. We have been glorifying negativity lately which distorts our sensibilities as a nation. It's high time that the youth becomes the agents of change and preserve the veracity of things”.

Talking about his experiences as an entrepreneur in the food industry, Mr. Shah Miftaur Rahman, Cofounder and CFOO (Chief Finance & Operations Officer) of Wow! Momo said, “We want to make a difference in the society. Employment is a major problem in India and it is up to the entrepreneurs to bring solve that problem”

Dr. Bhaskar Das, an eminent academician, and a veteran manager, talking about the truth, its fragility and accompanying phenomena in today’s world said, “Distortion of facts has been a part of life since primordial times, but the problem with the truth is that there are too many truths. Facts are multidimensional, and heightened anxiety is commonplace now”. He further added, “All of us individually are a part of the problem of vulnerabilities in truth, and so we can be part of the solution.”

Talking about her perspective on the theme, actress and model Apoorva Arora said, “Be yourself, since your flaws might not even be flaws, learn to accept yourself and others as you and they are”.
