DOCTORAL PROGRAMME IN MANAGEMENT

Introduction:

Indian Institute of Management Rohtak is a premier institute of management education in India. The Doctoral Programme in Management (DPM) of the Indian Institute of Management Rohtak is a full-time doctoral programme (Ph.D) offered in various disciplines. The programme aims at:

1. Developing high-quality researchers and academicians for educational institutions.
2. Producing top-quality management experts and thinkers for business organizations, government, and society.

Areas of Specialization:

The DPM will be offered in the following broad Areas:

- Economics and Public Policy
- Finance & Accounting
- Management Information Systems
- Marketing & Strategic Management
- Operations Management & Quantitative Techniques
- Organizational Behaviour & Human Resources Management

The programme duration is for four years. The participants are given a monthly Fellowship, waiver of tuition fees, contingency grant to attend international/national conferences and support for research visits to global partner institutions.

IIM Rohtak aims at excelling in interdisciplinary research globally and is deeply committed to foster fundamental, applied, and policy-oriented research. It is open to work with partners from academia, industry and government in fulfilling its goal of excellence. The Institute is strategically located in the National Capital Region and has proximity to the industrial clusters and the seats of policymakers. Doctoral Programme in Management (DPM) at IIM Rohtak strives to incorporate the strengths of similar programmes in other IIMs and other major institutions and has included specific innovative features as per the emerging needs. The DPM programme is in line with the vision of the institute to be a global leader in the creation and dissemination of knowledge in management and to be India's future global learning center like the ancient Nalanda was.

Admission Process:

The admission to DPM of IIM Rohtak is open to all Indian citizens, non-resident Indians, persons of Indian origin living abroad and other foreign citizens. Admission to the programme will be based on the academic qualifications, performance in the qualifying examination/tests, personal interviews and the work experience. The programme is fully residential for four years duration.



Basic Eligibility Criteria:

- **Basic Eligibility Criteria**

The candidate should have one of the following qualifications:

- Postgraduate degree or equivalent in any discipline with at least 55% marks or equivalent CGPA.
- Bachelor degree with at least 55% marks and Qualifications of CA, ICWA, or CS.
- Bachelor's degree with at least 55% marks and Qualifications of LLB degree.
- MBBS degree holders with at least 55% marks or equivalent CGPA + 12 months experience.
- 4-years / 8 Semesters Bachelor's degree, with at least 6.5 CGPA or equivalent marks + 12 months experience.
- Five years Integrated Master's Degree program in any discipline, with at least 55% marks.

ALL CANDIDATES MUST MEET THE BASIC ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND MUST HAVE TAKEN AT LEAST ONE OF THE QUALIFYING EXAMINATION LISTED BELOW TO BE SHORTLISTED.

*For Example, relevant subject areas are: Commerce, Computer and applications, Economics, Labour welfare and personal relation, Mass communication and journalism, Mathematical sciences, Management, Political science, Psychology, Public administration, Tourism and travel management

****Candidates who have a Master's Degree or candidates with M.Phil or candidates with a Master's Degree with the thesis in the relevant disciplines may directly appear for Research Aptitude Test (RAT) to be conducted by IIM Rohtak for shortlisting if they have 2 years of academic experience in a reputed educational institution. Institute will assess the nature and type of academic experience before shortlisting. The candidate must however have at least 55% marks in the master's degree program. Such candidates do not need to have the qualifying examinations mentioned in the above table.**

- Candidates possessing PGDM/MBA of IIMs with a minimum CGPA of 6.5 out of 10 or equivalent will be eligible for the interview process directly. Further, if selected, will be exempted from first year PGP course work (if any).
- Non-resident Indians, the person of Indian origin, and foreign citizens should have a valid GMAT/GRE score of not older than five years from the closing date of application.



Note: A candidate can apply in one Area on the payment of registration fee.

Personal Interview:

The shortlisted candidates will be called for a personal interview. The candidates will be assessed for their subject knowledge, research aptitude, and basic research understanding.

How to apply:

The online application form can be filled through following link on a payment of **Rs 1100/-** (for Indian Citizens) and **\$ 100** (for foreign citizens or NRIs) as registration charges. A separate application form to be filled in case of applying for more than one area with additional requisite registration charges of Rs. 1100/-. The printed application form along with all the documents to be submitted/sent through post to the institute after the online registration on or before January 31, 2021. The required documents for the DPM application are mentioned in Annexure A-1.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

The participants of the DPM will be given a Fellowship as mentioned below:

- Rs 30,000 for first two years and
- Rs 35,000 after passing the second year

Contingency Grant:

All the participants will receive a contingency grant of Rs. 1, 85,000/-distributed across four years of the programme. This grant is available only if the student performance is satisfactory and there is no disciplinary issue against the student.

Financial Support for Conferences/Academic Exchange:

The participants will be provided potential financial support for attending national and international conferences as well as for academic exchange visits to partner institutions as per the institute norms after recommendations of the DPM committee and Dean.

Hostel and Medical Facilities:

The DPM of IIM Rohtak is a full-time residential programme and all the participants are required to stay in the campus. The existing medical facilities that are being used by other students of the Institute will be available to them.

Important:

IIM Rohtak will not charge tuition fee from the participants who receive the fellowship. They are expected to pay for their food expenses and utility expenses, admission offer acceptance fee, alumni association fee, and any other fee specified by the Institute.

The participants who are admitted under the categories of non-resident Indians, persons of Indian origin living abroad and other foreign citizens will be required to pay the fees as specified by the Institute.
